

- Multiformat publishing framework
- Optimized for discovery and longevity
- Started in Getty Publications to publish our online, pdf, and ebook editions simultaneously from a single source
- Always intended to do at least a passive open source release
- Now partnering with our internal digital team
- Hiring full-time two-year Dev and Community Manager positions
- 100+ people in our beta so far







Sustainable software is that which is viable and effective for as long as it is needed.



It Takes a Village: Overview

•OSS Programs serving cultural and scientific heritage suffer from a lack of resources devoted to sustainability planning

•IMLS funded the It Takes a Village project in 2017

- Intended outcomes:
- -Survey, forum, and roadmap
- –Increased awareness of OSS sustainability requirements
- –Opportunities for joint projects and collaborations









ITAV: Major Findings

•Sustainable programs grow from community needs

•Sustainability is not one thing, nor is it a straight line

•Sustainability has *facets* that move in cyclical *phases* – together and separately

•Gathered info from survey and forum to develop Guidebook to serve as practical reference source for OSS programs

ITAV: Phases

•Getting Started


-Early stages of planning, design, and development

Growing

–Broadest, critical time to transition to sustainability

•Stable, but not Static

-Reflects more mature program; beware complacency





ITAV: Facets

Establishing roles and processes; how decisions get made

Efforts to foster involvement within a community; users > stakeholders



Software development and challenges that impact the development process

Human and financial resources in a variety of forms



ITAV: Guidebook

For each phase of each facet:

- •Characteristics where am I?
- Concerns common issues

•Moving forward - how do I move to the next phase or continue to evolve?





ITAV: Next Steps

- Round two at IMLS now
- •Focus on practical exercises
- Example: Catastrophizing
- –Brainstorm things that would have significant negative impact
- -How would you manage this event with your current governance structure?
- -How could you change/improve structure as a result?




